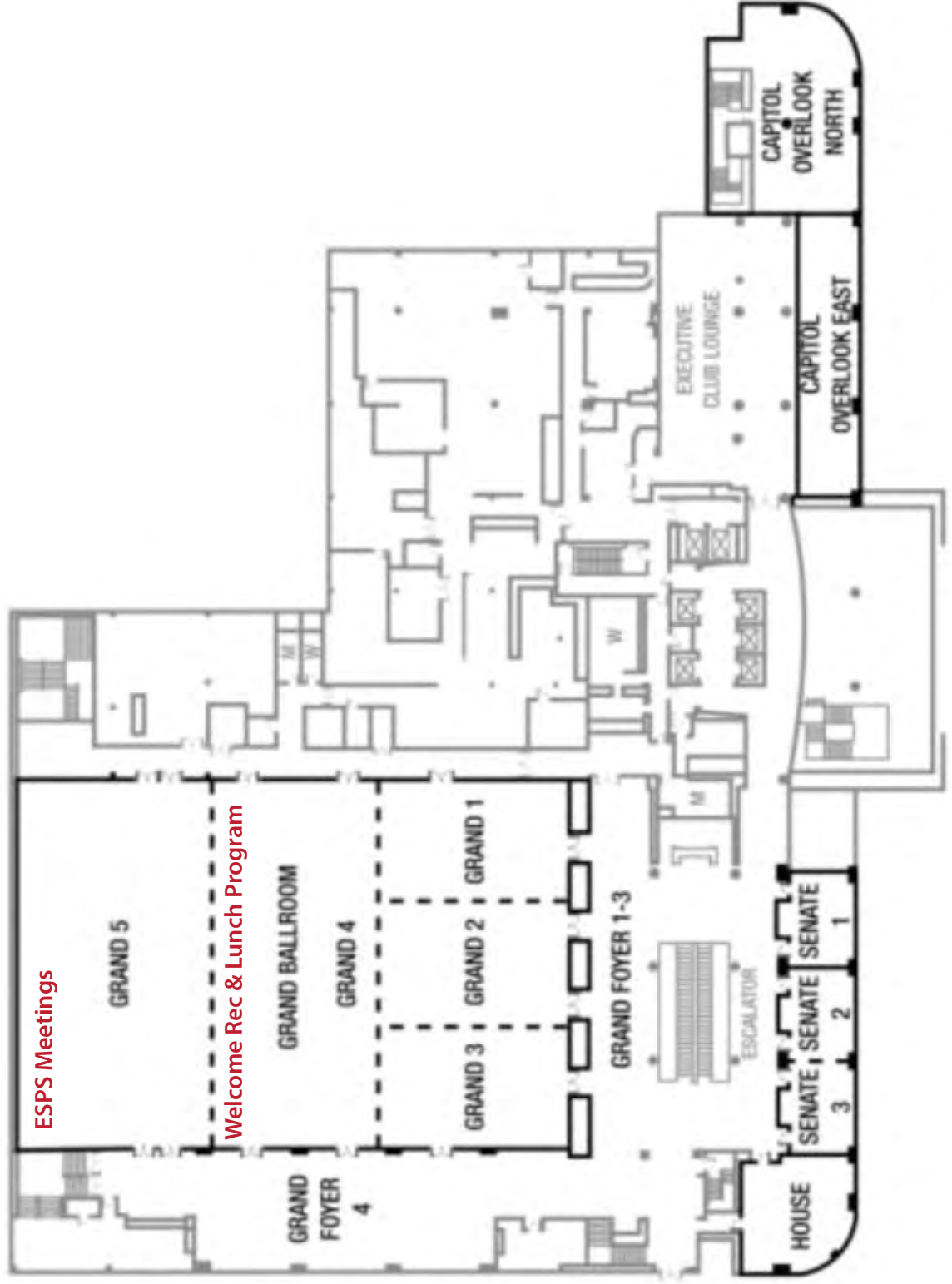

Antitrust Policy

All meeting participants should constantly bear in mind that under no circumstances should these meetings be used as opportunities to discuss with any competitors' or suppliers' personnel prices or terms or conditions of sale or any other topics which may involve you or your company in any dangers or risks of violation of the United States Antitrust and Trade Regulation Laws.

It is especially important that no such discussions should take place at informal sessions either before or after the scheduled meetings.

Please review the NFDA Antitrust Guidelines and/or consult with legal counsel for specific guidance along these lines.

NFDA ANTITRUST GUIDELINES

The antitrust laws prohibit agreements or understandings between two or more businesses to regulate prices or quantities of goods or services, to allocate customers or territories, to hinder or limit a competitor or potential competitor's operations or otherwise unreasonably to restrain business activity. Discriminatory pricing or servicing is also prohibited.

Violation of these laws can be costly and dangerous, involving possibly going to jail and heavy fines. The following rules are not complete. They highlight the more common problems, but other activity can be illegal. Any activity involving agreement or joint action with your competitor should be a red flag for you to be cautious.

DO NOT discuss or exchange information regarding your prices or competitor's prices with a competitor (except when buying from or selling to him, and then only those specifics).

DO NOT discuss or exchange information with competitors which might affect prices, such as price differentials, discounts, margins, costs or terms of sale.

DO NOT agree with competitors to uniform terms of sale, warranties or contract provisions.

DO NOT agree with competitors to divide customers or territories

DO NOT discuss your customers with your competitors.

DO NOT act jointly with one or more competitors to put another competitor at a disadvantage.

DO NOT try to prevent your supplier from selling to your competitor.

DO NOT discuss your future pricing, marketing or policy plans with your competitor.

DO NOT discuss bids or procedure for responding to bids. NEVER make courtesy bids.

DO NOT boycott or refuse to deal with any supplier or customer.

DO NOT discuss any subject with a competitor which affects competition.

OBJECT to any improper discussions in your presence. If they persist, LEAVE.

Follow these rules wherever you are, whether at a formal meeting, a social gathering, on the golf course or in an elevator.

REMEMBER, you must avoid even the appearance of antitrust violations. Say or do nothing from which anyone could believe or even suspect a conspiracy to restrain trade.

Conflict of Interest Policy

This Conflict of Interest Policy of the National Fastener Distributors Association (1) defines conflicts of interest; (2) identifies classes of individuals within the Organization covered by this policy; (3) facilitates disclosure of information that may help identify conflicts of interest; and (4) specifies procedures to be followed in managing conflicts of interest.

1. Definition of conflicts of interest. A conflict of interest arises when a person in a position of authority over the Organization may benefit financially from a decision he or she could make in that capacity, including indirect benefits such as to family members or businesses with which the person is closely associated. This policy is focused upon material financial interest of, or benefit to, such persons.
2. Individuals covered. Persons covered by this policy are the Organization's officers, directors, chief employed executive and chief employed finance executive.
3. Facilitation of disclosure. Persons covered by this policy will annually disclose or update to the Organization President on a form provided by the Organization their interests that could give rise to conflicts of interest, such as a list of family members, substantial business or investment holdings, and other transactions or affiliations with businesses and other organizations or those of family members.
4. Procedures to manage conflicts. For each interest disclosed to the Organization President, the President will determine whether to: (a) take no action; (b) assure full disclosure to the Board of Directors and other individuals covered by this policy; (c) ask the person to recuse from participation in related discussions or decisions within the Organization; or (d) ask the person to resign from his or her position in the Organization or, if the person refuses to resign, become subject to possible removal in accordance with the Organization's removal procedures. The Organization's chief employed executive will monitor proposed or ongoing transactions for conflicts of interest and disclose them to the Organization President in order to deal with potential or actual conflicts, whether discovered before or after the transaction has occurred
